ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

The Annual Membership Meeting of Fayette Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("FEC" of "Cooperative") was held on July 15, 2026 at the KC Community Center in La Grange, Texas, County of Fayette, with registration beginning at 5:30 p.m. and the business meeting commencing at 7:00 p.m.

The following Board of Directors were present: Joseph D. Kruppa, David A. Stancik, James A. Anderle, Scott Schultz, Clayton Wessels, and Jonathan Treptow. Also present was Carl Galant, the Cooperative's attorney.

President Kruppa called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and he stated the purpose of the meeting was to provide the board and management the opportunity to present an update on the activities of the Cooperative and to elect two directors to represent members in Districts 6 and 7.

After the invocation was presented by Director Scott Schultz, the members and their guests sang the National Anthem. President Joseph Kruppa then led the Pledge of Allegiance and the Pledge to the Texas Flag.

President Kruppa introduced the General Manager, Doug Lambert, who recognized the Fayette County 4-H Club members, leaders, and volunteers for their years of support and for providing and serving refreshments.

The General Manager recognized several special guests and thanked them for attending. He also recognized Ewald Kubota of La Grange and Kleiber Tractor & Equipment for the use of their utility vehicles to transport members and their guests to the front steps of the KC Community Center.

Finally, the General Manager recognized the Cooperative's employees who could be identified by their maroon pin-stripe shirts. He stated that they and Cooperative directors would be available after the meeting should they have a question or concern.

The President then introduced the directors and the Cooperative's attorney.

The President requested the Board Secretary report the number of members registered. Secretary Anderle reported that 373 members were present in person at the annual meeting, constituting a quorum, all of whom are listed in the attachment to these minutes.

The Secretary read the Official Notice of the Meeting followed by the Proof of Mailing, all being made a part of these minutes as Exhibits A & B.

The President then entertained a motion from the floor to dispense with the reading of last year's annual meeting minutes and approve them as presented. Upon motion by Glen Altwein, seconded by Larry Jackson, it was:

RESOLVED, That the membership dispensed with the reading of the minutes of the July 16, 2025 annual meeting and approved them as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Before the initial prize drawing was held, President Kruppa announced that each member who registered for the annual meeting would receive a \$20 energy bill credit as an attendance prize. This is a \$10 increase over what was given last year. This amount, he said, would be automatically deducted from their next utility bill.

Next, the President announced that there would be a drawing for attendance door prizes. Director Clayton Wessels drew the names of 20 door prize winners.

The President then asked FEC Attorney, Carl Galant, to report the names of those officially nominated at the District 6 and 7 meetings held in May and to conduct the election of the two directors.

Attorney Galant proceeded with the election of directors. He stated that the District 7 meeting was held on May 11, 2026, and that David Stancik was the only candidate nominated, and upon a voice vote, he received a unanimous vote of those present and voting and was thereupon declared to be the sole nominee for director of District 7. He then asked for a motion that David Stancik be elected director of District 7 by acclamation. Upon motion by Mike Dittrich, seconded by Dr. Thomas Mueller, it was:

RESOLVED, That David Stancik be elected as director of District 7.

Attorney Galant stated that the District 6 meeting was held on May 12, 2026, and that Clayton Wessels was the only candidate nominated, and upon a voice vote, he received a unanimous vote of those present and voting and was thereupon declared to be the sole nominee for director of District 6. He then asked for a motion that Clayton Wessels be elected director of District 6 by acclamation. Upon motion by Steve Lee, seconded by Dr. Thomas Mueller, it was:

RESOLVED, That Clayton Wessels be elected as director of District 6.

Attorney Galant then asked the newly elected directors to present a few brief remarks. Director Stancik and Director Wessels each took turns thanking the membership for electing them.

President Kruppa asked Tracy Denton to introduce the Scholarship and Youth Tour winners.

The 2026 Academic Scholarship winners, who will receive a \$1,500 scholarship, and their parents were introduced to the audience as follows:

The 2026 Trade & Technical School Scholarship winners, who will each receive a \$1,500 scholarship, and their parents were then introduced as follows:

Landon Chaloupka, son of Nicole and Chad Chaloupka.

Next, Mrs. Denton announced that a special drawing would be held at the meeting to award one \$1,500 scholarship to a graduate who did not receive a scholarship from the Cooperative's regular scholarship contest. This contest is called the "Luck of the Draw" Scholarship contest and was awarded to Sophie Vinklarek.

Next, Mrs. Denton introduced the 2026 Government-in-Action Youth Tour participants who presented short speeches about their trip to Washington, D.C.

Gretchen Sacks, daughter of Jacquelyn and Michael Sacks, and Laney Bludau, daughter of Jo Ann and Ronnie Bludau, spoke about their experiences on the trip and likely inspired other local youths to apply.

General Manager, Doug Lambert then presented the Report of the Board and Management for the year 2025 through a videotaped message.

The President asked for a motion to accept the Report of the Board and Management for the year 2025. Upon motion by Steve Lee, seconded by Mike Dittrich, it was:

RESOLVED, That the Report of the Board and Management for the year 2025 be accepted.

Next, the President announced that there would be another drawing for attendance door prizes. Director Jonathan Treptow drew the names of 20 door prize winners.

President Kruppa then announced that Director James Anderle would draw the names of the Children's Prize Drawing. Five winners' names were announced.

The President called on General Manager Doug Lambert to announce the winners of the Sharing Success Grant Program. The General Manager, with the assistance of President Joseph Kruppa, presented grants to the following non-profit organizations:

Round Top Schuetzen Verein Preservation, Inc for \$2500.00

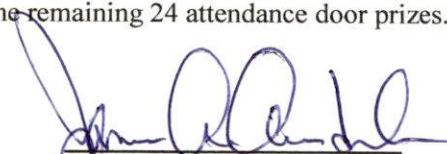
Greater Fayette Community Foundation for the Liberty Tree Project for \$3,000
